Bloodroot (*Sanguinaria canadensis*) is an ephemeral plant with white flowers in early spring. They prefer average soil in part sun or shade making them well-suited for the banks and slopes of shaded rain gardens where they'll grow about 6 inches tall. They should be interplanted with species that fill in the voids left once dormant. Companion plants include Woodland Phlox (*Phlox divaricata*) and Rosy Sedge (*Carex rosea*).
